

Paint markers

Outstanding adhesion especially on smooth, porous and dark surfaces. Extremely wear-resistant on almost all surfaces. Waterproof, quick-drying. edding 750, 751 and 780 are heat-resistant up to 400°C (colours 005-010, 049, 054 still visible up to 1000°C). Pump system, shake before use, remove cap and pump. Ink with no added toluene/xylene.

For highly opaque marking of virtually all materials such as glass, plastic, wood and metal. Also especially good on dark and transparent materials

Paint marker with bullet nib. permanent, low-odour pigment ink providing an opaque lacquer finish.



Gloss paint markers - glass metal, plastic, paper

Paint markers for brilliant designs on almost all smooth surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, leather, paper and much more). Low-odour, gloss finish for permanent and waterproof marking and decorating, e.g., for greeting cards and gifts. Also suitable for dark and transparent materials. Quick-drying, weatherproof, very lightfast and smudge-proof. Pump system, shake before use, remove cap and pump.

Activation of the edding gloss paint marker: Shake the marker well with the cap on, place the writing nib of the marker on a piece of test paper, pump a few times by pressing down on the nib carefully until the ink appears in the nib. Check the marker by drawing a few lines on the piece of test paper. Put the cap back on after use.
